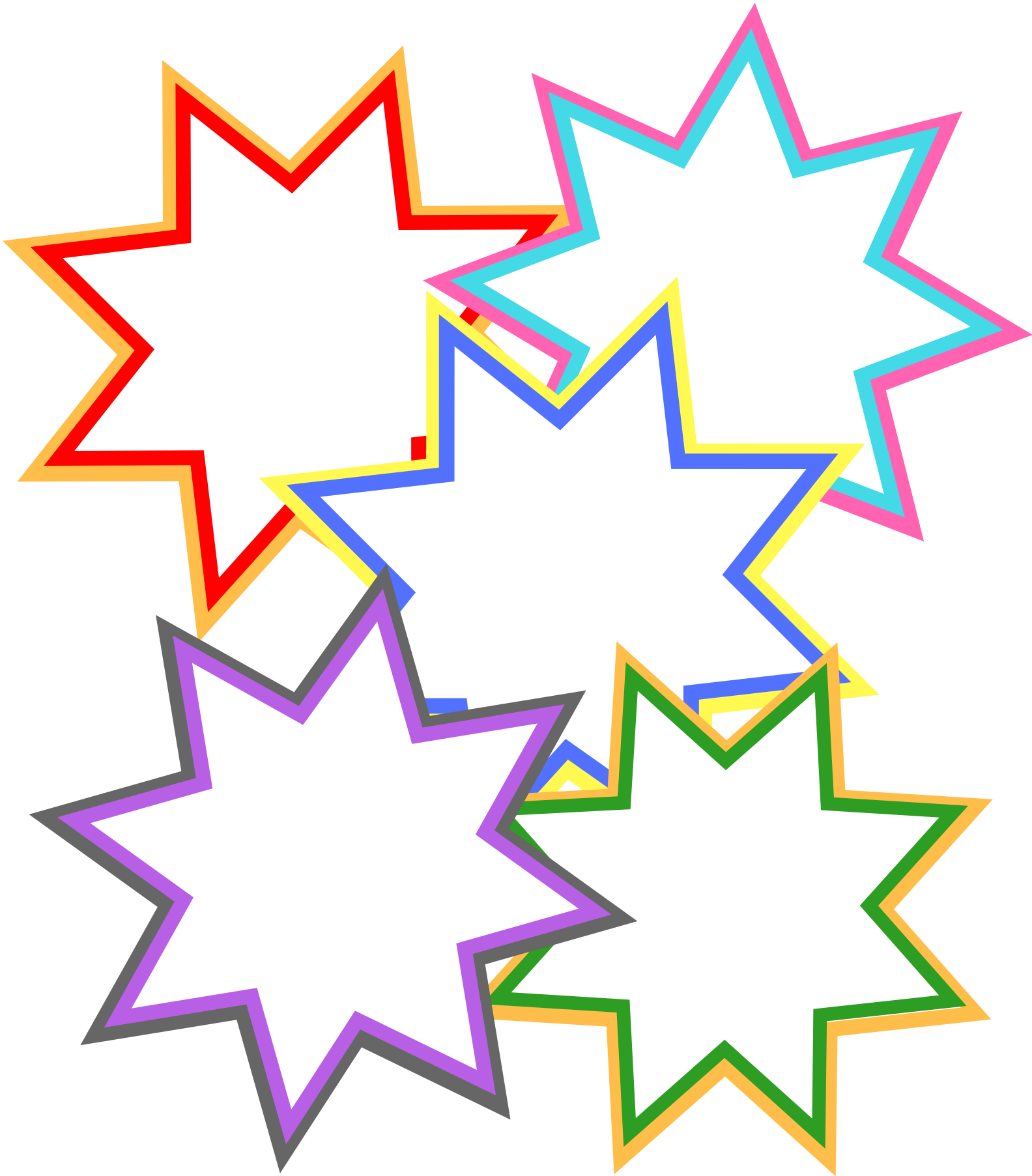
With the love and power of God, we can be very dangerous because we can change the world. That is our calling. Our purpose. Are you ready?

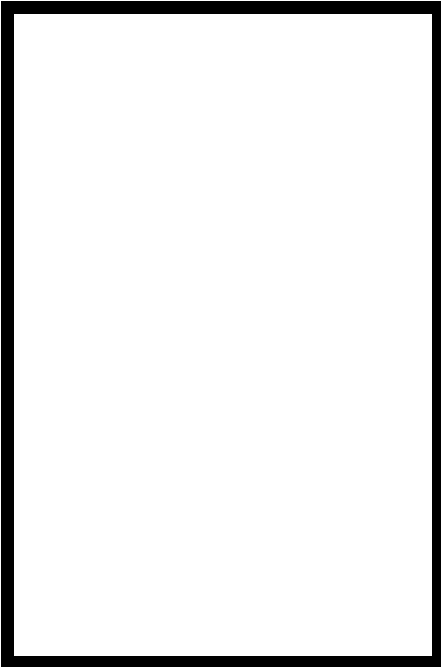
This training will make you a better X-Men, but it will take discipline. It will take perseverance. You cannot give up! We believe you can do it. Let's go!

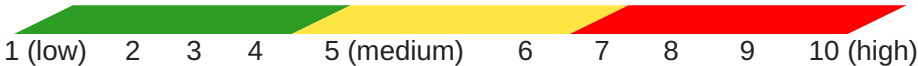

Worship and prayer connect us to God, and when we're connected to the Source of all power, we grow, we learn, we are blessed, and we are able to change the world.

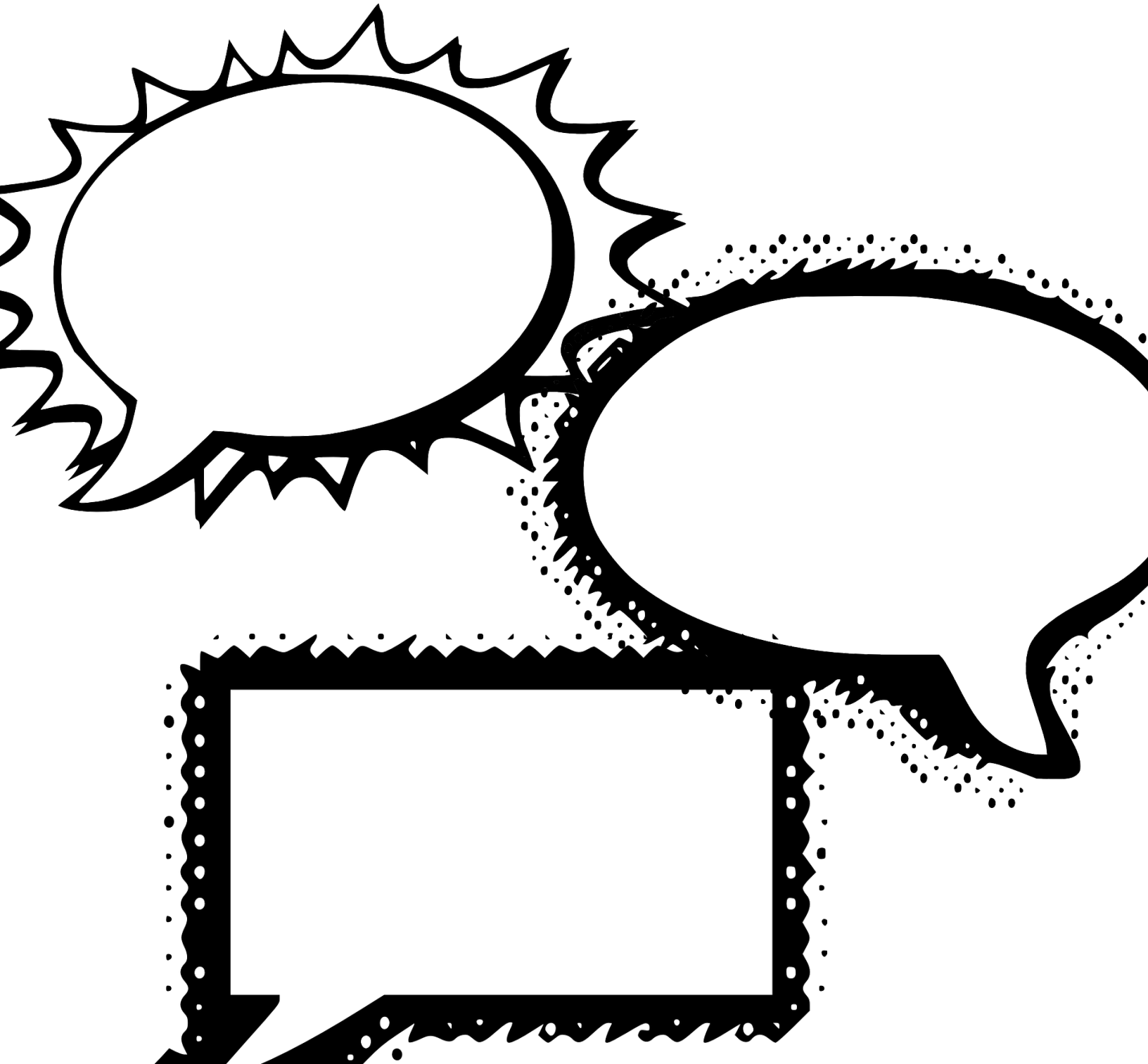

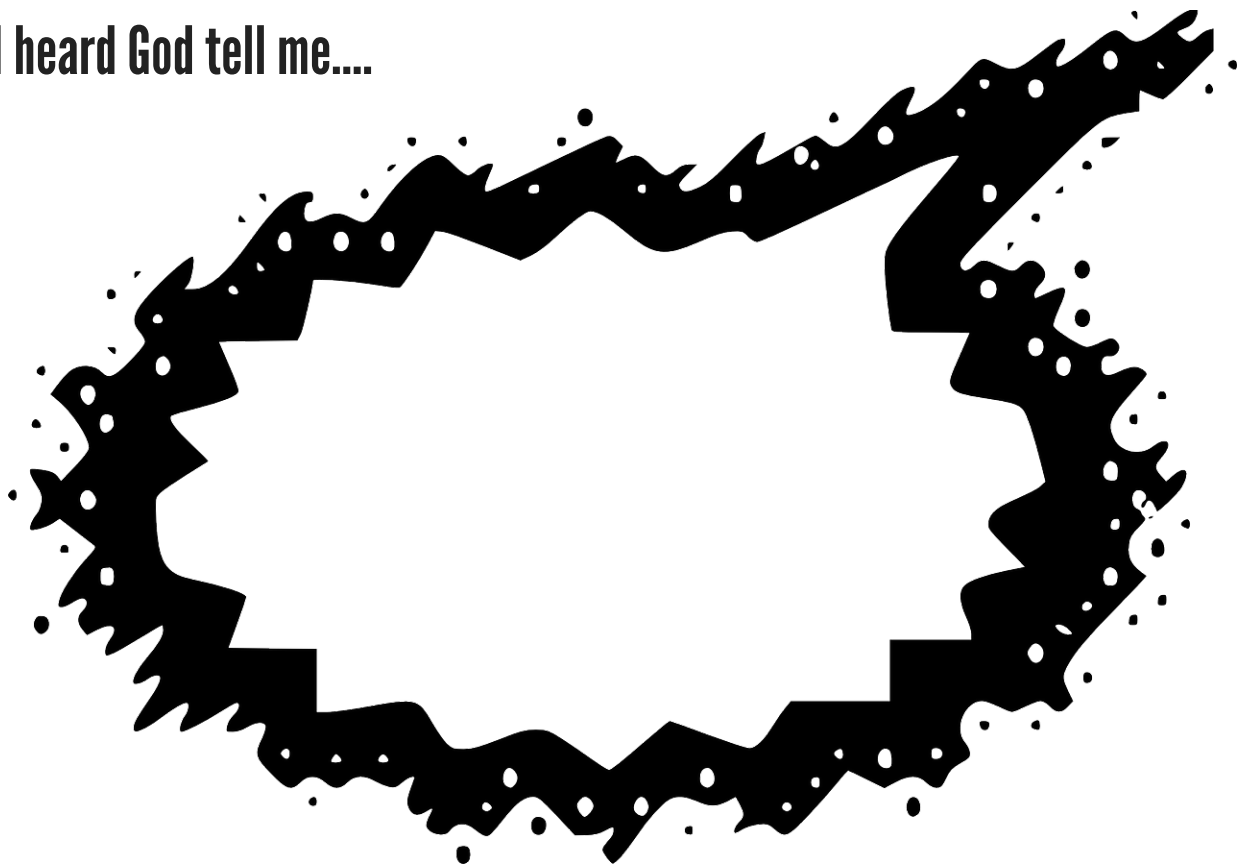
